

Thirtieth Sunday in Ordinary Time ~ October 29, 2023 Liturgical Color:

Parents: We invite you to spend some time discussing this weekend's readings with your children. By helping them understand God's word, you will help build a strong foundation of faith!

Theme: Jesus teaches us about love.

Reading (Exodus 22:21-37)

In today's first reading, God tells us to care for others, especially those in need.

Gospel (Matthew 22:34-39)
