WORSHIP AID

GLORIA:

Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace to people of good will. We praise you, we bless you, we adore you, we glorify you, we give you thanks for your great glory, Lord God, heavenly King, O God, almighty Father. Lord Jesus Christ, Only Begotten Son, Lord God, Lamb of God, Son of the Father, you take away the sins of the world, have mercy on us; you take away the sins of the world, receive our prayer; you are seated at the right hand of the Father, have mercy on us. For you alone are the Holy One, you alone are the Lord, you alone are the Most High, Jesus Christ, with the Holy Spirit, in the glory of God the Father.

FIRST READING: Ezekiel 34:11-12, 15-17

Thus says the Lord God:

I myself will look after and tend my sheep. As a shepherd tends his flock when he finds himself among his scattered sheep, so will I tend my sheep. I will rescue them from every place where they were scattered when it was cloudy and dark. I myself will pasture my sheep; I myself will give them rest, says the Lord God. The lost I will seek out, the strayed I will bring back, the injured I will bind up, the sick I will heal, but the sleek and the strong I will destroy, shepherding them rightly. As for you, my sheep, says the Lord God, I will judge between one sheep and another, between rams and goats.

SECOND READING: 1 Corinthians 15:20-26, 28

Brothers and sisters:

Christ has been raised from the dead, the firstfruits of those who have fallen asleep. For since death came through man, the resurrection of the dead came also through man. For just as in Adam all die, so too in Christ shall all be brought to life, but each one in proper order: Christ the firstfruits; then, at his coming, those who belong to Christ; then comes the end, when he hands over the kingdom to his God and Father, when he has destroyed every sovereignty and every authority and power. For he must reign until he has put all his enemies under his feet. The last enemy to be destroyed is death. When everything is subjected to him, then the Son himself will also be subjected to the one who subjected everything to him, so that God may be all in all.

Lector: The Word of the Lord. ALL: Thanks be to God.

GOSPEL: Matthew 25:31-46

Jesus said to his disciples:

"When the Son of Man comes in his glory, and all the angels with him, he will sit upon his glorious throne, and all the nations will be assembled before him. And he will separate them one from another, as a shepherd separates the sheep from the goats. He will place the sheep on his right and the goats on his left. Then the king will say to those on his right, 'Come, you who are blessed by my Father. Inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world. For I was hungry and you gave me food, I was thirsty and you gave me drink, a stranger and you welcomed me, naked and you clothed me, ill and you cared for me, in prison and you visited me.' Then the righteous will answer him and say, 'Lord, when did we see you hungry and feed you, or thirsty and give you drink? When did we see you a stranger and welcome you, or naked and clothe you? When did we see you ill or in prison, and visit you?' And the king will say to them in reply, 'Amen, I say to you, whatever you did for one of the least brothers of mine, you did for me.' Then he will say to those on his left, 'Depart from me, you accursed, into the eternal fire prepared for the devil and his angels. For I was hungry and you gave me no food, I was thirsty and you gave me no drink, a stranger and you gave me no welcome, naked and you gave me no clothing, ill and in prison, and you did not care for me.' Then they will answer and say, 'Lord, when did we see you hungry or thirsty or a stranger or naked or ill or in prison, and not minister to your needs?' He will answer them, 'Amen, I say to you, what you did not do for one of these least ones, you did not do for me.' And these will go off to eternal punishment, but the righteous to eternal life."

PROFESSION OF FAITH

He ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of the Father. He will come again in glory to judge the living and the dead and his kingdom will have no end. I believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the giver of life, who proceeds from the Father and the Son, who with the Father and the Son is adored and glorified, who has spoken through the prophets. I believe in one, holy, catholic and apostolic Church. I confess one Baptism for the forgiveness of sins and I look forward to the resurrection of the dead and the life of the world to come. Amen.

Outreach

During this past fiscal year, St. Kilian parishioners responded when called for the support for others. In addition to donations to our own Outreach program helping the local community, and to the Diocese-wide collections such as the Retired Religious, Holy Land and the Missionary from El Salvador, donations were made to our humanitarian fund designated to helping others in need. This past year, we assisted those devastated by the effect of Hurricane Ian and also the Syrians and Turkish after their destructive earthquake. In total our parish gave about \$290,000 this past year to assist those in need!

Construction

We completed our remodel project of our Parish Hall with tremendous support and enthusiasm! We gained occupancy just in time to host four of our usual six Fish Fry Fridays, and celebrated our overflow Easter Sunday Masses. The new hall is beautiful and is becoming a popular space for celebrations and memorials, large gatherings and we now have wedding receptions on the schedule. In addition, our upstairs hall is serving as an ideal space for our youth each week, as well as a great gathering space for ministry meetings, Bible studies and other larger groups that exceed the space of our existing classrooms.

We have continued our Capital Campaign to help fund our next project, the Rectory remodel and the building of a Retired Priests' home. After many long months, we are now under way, expecting to be complete before Summer 2024. We look forward to their completion—now able to accommodate three active priests in the Rectory, and to offer housing for inactive priests in the Retired Priests' home.

Many thanks are extended to our Parish Finance Council for their gifts of time and talent during this past year. We are blessed by their commitment to the stewardship and integrity of our Parish finances, and providing support and guidance to our pastor, Fr. Angelos Sebastian.

St. Kilian Church Financials: Fiscal Year July 1, 2022 - June 30, 2023

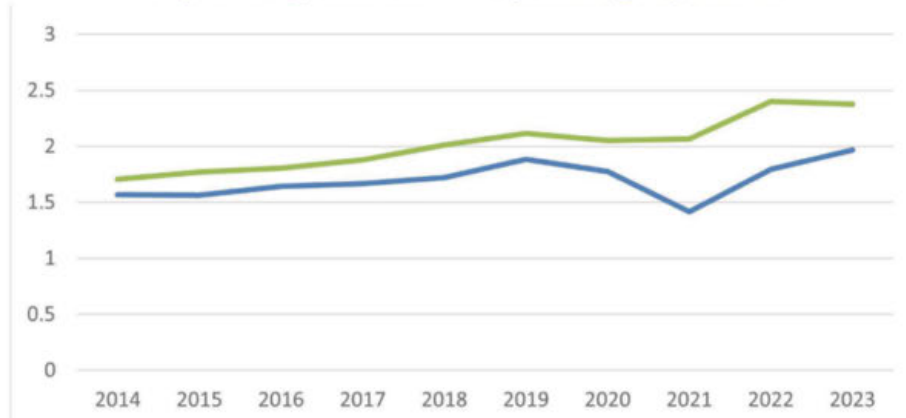

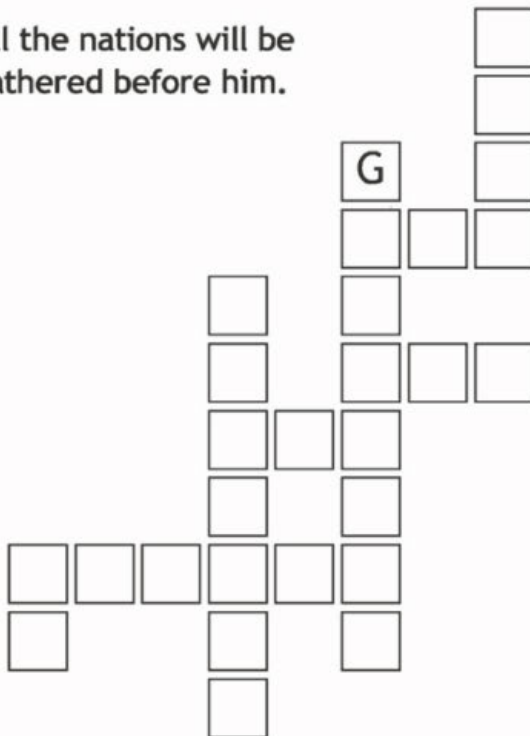
